JUMP START 101 FROM UNCLE JAY

So your battery is dead... 1st thing: **Call** your boss, school, or whoever will be waiting on you - because you are late! Then follow these 5 easy steps:

1. Grab your jumper cables and a vehicle with a good battery!
2. It doesn't matter to me what vehicle you hook up first BUT always hook matching colors to same polarity. *Example: red to positive / black to negative*
ALWAYS hook the ground (black or negative) last. Connect it to a good metal object on the engine or in the engine compartment. (It should spark when you hook it up and I want that away from the battery)
3. After hooking cables, let vehicle with good battery run for 10-15 minutes this charges the dead battery

IMPORTANT: MAKE SURE ALL ELECTRICAL ACCESSORIES ARE TURNED OFF SO THAT YOU DON'T SPIKE THE ELECTRICAL SYSTEM....

4. After dead vehicle has started, leave cables hooked up for 2-5 minutes to not spike the electrical system again.
5. Remove ground cable hooked to engine or engine compartment first to avoid sparks around the battery vapors. Then remove other cable ends and get to work – you are late!
